Healing is our inheritance

When Jesus taught His disciples to pray He Himself said, "Let your will be done on earth as it is in heaven." Matthew 6:9, 10. There is no sickness or disease in heaven, nor was there sickness or disease in the Garden of Eden. God's perfect will is health, as it was in the Garden, and as it still is and always will be, in heaven. God's Word gives us God's will.

God is no respecter of persons (Acts 10:34) and He never changes (Malachi 3:6). So what He said to them yesterday, He is saying to you today. God's Word is God speaking to you/me.

It is important for us to feed on the Word of God to build our faith. When we meditate on healing scriptures it builds our faith to receive healing. "Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God" (Romans 10:17). We want to encourage you to meditate on these scriptures daily. We do.

We have personalized as many of the verses as possible, so that it will be more meaningful to you. It would also be meaningful to yo if you put your name in the verse in place of "you" or "yours". Please feel free to print these verses, so that you can have them at any time to read and study.

Remember that one of the most important truths to realize is that you have already been healed through Christ's work on the cross, so it is a matter of receiving what He's already paid for you! THAT'S GOOD news!

The following Scriptures are all listed in order of the Audio Teaching: **Healing Scriptures**. You can print them off and then read them along with the teaching.

Proverbs 14:30

A heart at peace gives life to the body.

Proverbs 4:20-22

You word is life to me who's found them and health (medicine) to all my flesh.

Isaiah 53:5

By His Wounds I am healed.

Psalm 30:2

Lord my God, I called to you for help and You healed me.

Exodus 15:26

You are the Lord who heals me.

Psalm 103:3

Praise the Lord, O my soul and forget not all of His benefits: Who forgives all my sins and heals all my diseases.

Joel 3:10

Let the weak say, I am strong! (Notice it is the weak saying they are strong!)

Proverbs 17:22

My cheerful heart is good medicine.

Exodus 23:25

I will worship the Lord my God and His blessing will be on my food and water. He will take sickness from among us and none will miscarry or be barren in our land!

Matthew 6:9, 10

Jesus prayed: Your Kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

3 John 2

Dear friend, I pray that you may enjoy good health and that all may go well with you, even as your soul is getting along well.

I John 5:14, 15

And this is the confidence the assurance, the privilege of boldness which I have in Him: I am sure that if I ask anything, make any request according to His will in agreement with His own plan, He listens to and hears me. And if I positively know that He listens to me in whatever I ask, I also know with settled and absolute knowledge that I have (granted us as our present possessions) the requests made of Him. (AMP)

Why should I die before my time? (AMP)

Isaiah 40:31

But because I wait for the Lord [expect, look for, and hope in Him] I shall change and renew my strength and power; I shall lift my wings and mount up [close to God as eagles mount up to the sun]; I shall run and not be weary, I will walk and not faint or become tired. (AMP)

Romans 8:31

If God is for me, who can be against me?

Romans 8:32

He who did not spare His own Son, but gave Him up for us all-how will He not also, along with Him, graciously give us all things?

Isaiah 41:10

I do not fear, for You are with me. I am not dismayed, for You are my God. You will strengthen me and help me; You will uphold me with Your righteous right hand.

Proverbs 16:24

Pleasant words are a honeycomb sweet to the soul, healing to the bones.

Jeremiah 30:17

But you are restoring me to health and healing my wounds.

Psalm 118:17

I will not die, but live and proclaim what the Lord has done.

Jeremiah 33:6

You will heal me and let me enjoy abundant peace and security.

2 Kings 20:5

You have heard my prayer and seen my tears, you will heal me.

I Peter 2:24

By His stripes I am healed!

Luke 8:50

Don't be afraid JUST BELIEVE and you will be healed.

Galatians 3:13

I am redeemed from the curse (the curse listed in Deuteronomy 28)

Malachi 3:6

I the Lord, do not change.

Below are Scriptures pertaining to the work Jesus did while on earth:

Matthew 8:13

Go! It will be done just as *you* believed it would.' And his servant was healed at that very hour.

(It is done just as I believe it would be.)

Matthew 9:35

Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom and healing EVERY disease and sickness. (Jesus healed them all and all includes me.)

Matthew 8:2,3

Jesus said, I am willing, be clean! (He is willing, so I am healed.)

Matthew 8:17

This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: He took up our infirmities and carried our diseases.

Matthew 9:22

Jesus turned and saw her. Take heart daughter, your faith has healed you. (My faith has healed me!)

Matthew 9:29, 30

Then He said, 'According to your faith will it be done to you.' And their sight was restored.

(According to my faith, it is done to me.)

Matthew 12:15

Many followed Him and He healed all their sick. (I follow You and You've healed me!)

Matthew 12:18

The tongue of the wise brings healing.

Mark 3:5

Jesus said to the man, 'Stretch out your hand'. He stretched it out, and his hand was completely restored.

Mark 6:12,13

They went out and preached that people should repent. They drove out many demons and anointed many sick people with oil and healed them.

Mark 6:54-56

As soon as they got out of the boat, people recognized Jesus. They ran throughout that whole region and carried the sick on mats to wherever they heard He was, and wherever He went-into villages, towns or countryside-they placed the sick in marketplaces. They begged Him to let them touch even the edge of His cloak, and all who touched Him were healed.

Mark 10:27

Jesus looked at them and said, 'With man this is impossible, but not with God; all things are possible with God.

Mark 11:22-24

Have faith in God, Jesus answered. I tell you the truth, if anyone says to this mountain, go throw yourself into the sea, and does not doubt in his heart but believes that what he says will happen, it will be done for him. Therefore I tell you, whatever you askf or in prayer, believe that you have received it and it will be yours.

Mark 16:17, 18

And these signs will accompany those who believe: they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well.

Acts 10:37, 38

You know what has happened throughout Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John preached-God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power, and how He went around doing good and healing all who were under the power of the devil, because God was with Him.

Acts 3:1-10

One day Peter and John were going up to the temple at the time of prayer-at three in the afternoon. Now a man crippled from birth was being carried to the temple gate called Beautiful, where he was put every day to beg from those going into the temple courts. When he saw Peter and John about to enter, he asked them for money. Peter looked straight at him, as did John. Then Peter said, Look at us! So the man gave them his attention, expecting to get something from them.

Then Peter said, Silver or gold I do not have, but what I have I give you. In the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk. Taking him by the right hand, he helped him up, and instantly the man's feet and ankles became strong. He jumped to his feet and began to walk. Then he went with them into the temple courts, walking and jumping, and praising God.

When all the people saw him walking and praising God, they recognized him as the same man who used to sit begging at the temple gate called Beautiful, and they were filled with wonder, and amazement at what had happened to him.

Acts 3:16

By faith in the Name of Jesus, this "me" whom you see and know is made strong. It is Jesus' Name and the faith that comes through Him that has completely healed me as you can all see.

Acts 5:12 and verses 15-16

The apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders among the people.

As a result, people brought the sick into the streets and laid them on beds and mats so that at least Peter's shadow might fall on some of them as he passed by. Crowds gathered also from the towns around Jerusalem, bringing their sick and those tormented by evil spirits, and all of them were healed.

Acts 9:32-35

As Peter traveled about the country, he went to visit the saints in Lydda. There he found a man named Onnus (Aeneas), a paralytic who had been bedridden for eight years. Onnus, Peter said to him, Jesus Christ heals you. Get up and take care of your mat. Immediately Onnus got up. All those who lived in Lydda and Sharon saw him and turned to the Lord.

The following Scriptures are in addition. They are not listed on the Audio Teaching.

Proverbs 15:30

Good news gives health to the bones.

Joel 2:25,26

You will restore to me the years the locust have eaten. I will eat in plenty and be satisfied and praise the Name of the Lord my God who has dealt wondrously with me and I will never be afraid.

Psalm 107:20

He sent out His Word and healed them. (He sent forth His Word and healed me!)

2 Corinthians 1:20

For no matter how many promises God has made, they are 'yes' in Christ. And so through Him the 'Amen' is spoken by us to the glory of God. (It brings glory to God when we believe and receive his promises! Hallelujah!)

Psalm 34:19,20

The righteous man may have many troubles, but the Lord delivers me from all my troubles!

Deuteronomy 30:19-20

This day I call the heavens and the earth as witnesses against you that I have set before you life and death, blessings and curses. Now choose life, so that you and your children may live! (God gives me the choice and I choose life!)

Psalm 105:37

He brought out Israel laden with silver and gold, and from among their tribes no one faltered!

(I am one of God's 'tribe' and I do not falter because I am STRONG!)

Deuteronomy 7:14,15

You will be blessed more than any other people; none of of your men or women will be childless, nor will any of your livestock be without young. The LORD will keep you free from every disease.

(The LORD keeps me free from every disease!)

Proverbs 23:7

As a man thinks in his heart so is he.

(I think in my heart that I am saved, healed, delivered and set free, so I am!)

Romans 8:11

And if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of His Spirit who lives in you. (His Spirit gives life to my mortal body!)

Psalm 35:27,28

The LORD be exalted who delights in the well-being of His servant. (The LORD delights in my well-being!)

I Kings 8:56

Not one word has failed of all the good promises He gave through His servant Moses.

Genesis 20:17

Then Abraham prayed to God, and God healed Abimelek, his wife and his female slaves so they could have children again.

2 Chronicles 30:20

And the Lord heard Hezekiah and healed the people.

Proverbs 3:7,8

Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD and shun evil. This will bring health to your body and nourishment to your bones.

Proverbs 12:18

The tongue of the wise brings healing.

Hebrews 11:1

Faith is being sure of what I hope for and certain of what I do not see.

Hebrews 11:11
